Trimbach Alsace, France 13%
Full, rich, complex. It shows great
finesse. It is the limestone soil of
Riesling which gives this
unique complexity.

2008 Chablis 1er Cru,
Montée de Tonnerre

Burgundy, France 13%
Bright white gold in colour with a
pronounced, vibrant nose showing
citrus and floral aromas with hints of
brioche. The palate is full of mineral
flavours alongside zippy citrus and
green apple characteristics. The
finish is elegant and very fine.
